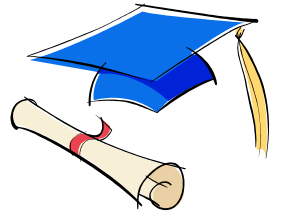




RESPONSIBILITY LESSON
