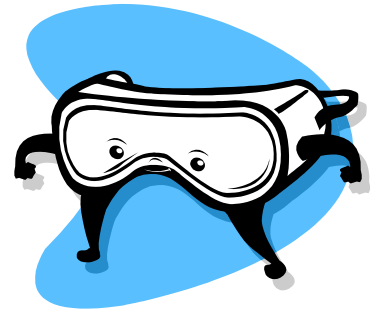




## Safety Lesson

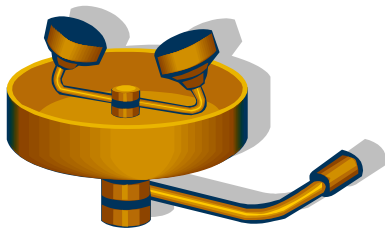


I understand the safety of others and myself is essential for a school to be able to work. Students and teachers cannot function in a setting where their safety is at risk.
